# Chapter 1

Linked presentations	A pre-defined sequence of presentations that play together as a group. For example, during an exam you can use the <b>Links</b> feature to show presentations from several categories. For more information, see <a href="#">"Playing Linked Presentations" on page 15.</a>
Gallery	<p>A set of photos, graphic illustrations, and silent, 3-D animations. If desired, you can select the <b>Gallery</b> images to supplement your explanations to patients about dental problems and the results after treatment.</p> <p>Most of the topic menus contain a <b>Gallery</b> menu of images. In particular, the <b>Esthetic Solutions</b> menu contains 192 before and after images, categorized by esthetic procedure. For more information, see <a href="#">"Using Image Galleries" on page 17.</a></p>
Preview	<p>A continuous loop of videos and images (similar to a screen saver) that plays automatically and serves as a marketing tool for your services.</p> <p>The <b>Previews</b> feature educates and entertains your patients with esthetic topics, hygiene presentations, before and after photos, and more. For more information, see <a href="#">"Playing Previews" on page 16.</a></p>

## Chapter 2

# Using CAESY DVD 2007

Using CAESY DVD 2007, you can play single presentations, preset sequences of linked presentations, or a continuous loop of short presentations (called **Previews**). Also, you can open galleries of dental images to illustrate your own explanations.

You can control a variety of CAESY DVD settings to make the program fit the needs of the practice. This chapter shows you how to:

# Starting CAESY DVD

You can use CAESY DVD on a computer or a DVD player.

## *Starting CAESY DVD on a Computer*

### **To start CAESY DVD on a computer**

- 1 Insert the CAESY DVD 2007 disc into the DVD-ROM drive, logo side up.
- 2 If the program does not begin to play automatically, follow the instructions for the DVD playback software program.

## *Starting CAESY DVD on a DVD Player*

### **To start CAESY DVD on a DVD player**

- 1 Turn on the television.
- 2 Based on how your DVD player is connected to the television, select the input so you can view the pictures from the DVD player.
- 3 Press **Power** to turn on the DVD player.
- 4 Open the player door by pressing the **Open/Close** button.
- 5 Place the CAESY DVD 2007 disc into the DVD player, logo side up.
- 6 Press **Open/Close** to close the tray door and begin playback.

## Operating the DVD

Your computer control or DVD remote may look different than the illustrations in this section. The actual DVD device depends on the make and model for your computer or DVD player. However, the functions are essentially the same, regardless of whether you operate CAESY DVD on a computer or on a DVD player.

### DVD Controls on Computers

You can access CAESY DVD's **Main Menu** selections (topic categories, **Previews** loop, customized settings) with a computer's DVD control by clicking **Menu**, and then clicking **Root Menu**. Also, you can access the **DVD Settings** menu by clicking **Title Menu**.

Depending on your DVD software, you can use many of these functions by right-clicking with your computer mouse. For example, with PowerDVD playback software, you can right-click to display all available options, and then click **Select Menu** to display CAESY DVD menus.

On your computer monitor, by default, CAESY DVD displays as a window.

- To use CAESY DVD as a full-screen display, double-click on the CAESY DVD image on your computer screen.
- To return CAESY DVD to a smaller window image, double-click on the computer screen again.

#### Sample control for computer DVD



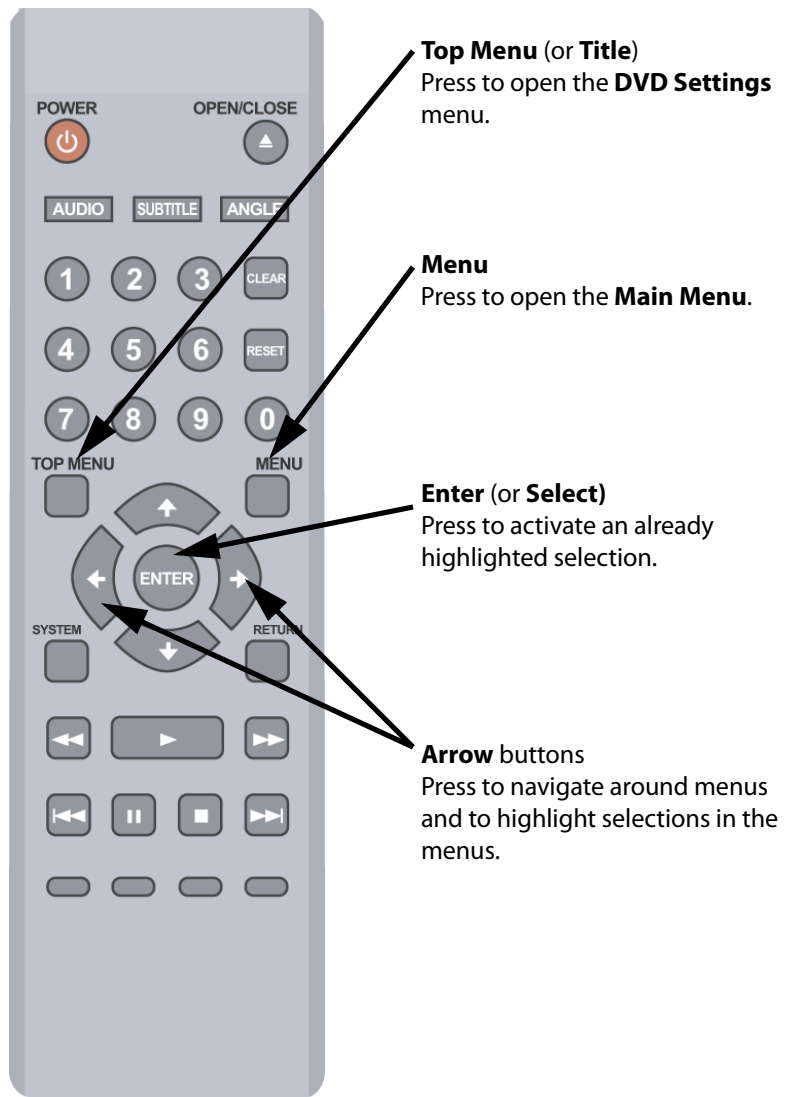
Click **Menu**. To go to CAESY DVD's **Main Menu**, click **Root Menu**. Or, to go to the **DVD Settings** menu, click **Title Menu**.

Click these buttons to use standard features, such as **Play** (center arrow), **Pause** (top), **Next** (right), **Previous** (left), or **Stop** (bottom).

## Remotes for DVD Players

You can access the CAESY DVD's **Main Menu** selections (topic categories, **Previews** loop, customized settings) with a DVD player's remote device by pressing the **Menu** button. Also, you can access the **DVD Settings** menu by pressing the **Top Menu** or **Title** button.

## Opening the Main Menu

Opening the **Main Menu** is the first step for many of the procedures in this guide. It will open automatically just after the copyright screen when you first start playing the program. However, you can open the **Main Menu** at any time.



**Opening CAESY DVD's Main Menu:** On your DVD remote or computer control, select **Menu** or **Root Menu**. Or, select **Main Menu** or **Previous** (left arrow icon) if you are already in another CAESY DVD menu.

From CAESY DVD's **Main Menu**, you can:

- Use [navigational icons](#).
- Select [topics](#) and play their associated presentations.
- Play a [set of presentations](#) as a sequential ("linked") presentation.
- Start or customize [Previews](#) of dental services in a continuous loop (similar to a screen saver).
- Select [galleries](#) (collections of videos and still images) to play silently, as a supplement to your own explanations.
- Play [Esthetic Dentistry](#) presentations, and use the **Esthetic Solutions** menu as a gallery of before and after images.
- Customize the [settings](#) for language, subtitles, preview options, and audio.

## Navigating through CAESY DVD

Every CAESY DVD screen includes icons for standard navigational tools, including:

- **Return** (double left arrow icon): Return to the previous menu, or go back two screens.
- **Previous** (left arrow icon): Go back to the previous screen.
- **Next** (right arrow icon): Go forward to the next screen.
- **Gallery** (framed picture icon): View a collection of silent images for the topic.
- **Links** (chain/links icon): Select a sequence of presentations to play for the topic.
- **Previews** (window/computer screen icon): Manually start the continuous loop of marketing presentations.
- **Settings** (tool icon): Customize the CAESY DVD settings for language, subtitles, and **Previews**.

If the icon is gray-shaded, it is unavailable at the specific screen.



**CAESY DVD Navigational Tools:** *The icons at the bottom of every CAESY DVD screen allow you to navigate backward and forward, view the **Gallery** of silent images, select a set of linked presentations, start the **Previews** loop, or customize the default settings.*

## Stopping CAESY DVD

You can stop CAESY DVD at any time.

### To stop CAESY DVD temporarily

- On a DVD player or its remote control, press the **Pause** button.
- On a computer with PowerDVD, click **Pause** on the control panel.

Pausing CAESY DVD stops whatever is currently playing (such as a presentation or the **Previews** loop). To resume playing CAESY DVD from where you paused:

- On a DVD player or its remote control, press the **Enter** (or **Select**) button.
- On a computer with PowerDVD, click **Play** on the control panel.

### To turn off CAESY DVD

- On a DVD player or its remote control, press the **Stop** button.
- On a computer with PowerDVD, click **Stop** on the control panel.



*When you turn off CAESY DVD, any customized settings are lost. For more information, see ["Customizing CAESY DVD"](#) on page 22.*

# Playing CAESY Presentations

You can play CAESY presentations in two ways:

- As a single presentation
- As a sequence of presentations that are grouped (linked) together



You may want to use the CAESY DVD 2007 Presentation Checklist to “prescribe” presentations to your patients. CAESY provides this form with your CAESY DVD 2007 shipment. For more information, contact CAESY. See “Contact Us” on page 35.

## Playing a Single Presentation

You can play individual CAESY presentations from the 17 topic menus. The presentations in each topic are grouped into categories, such as Diagnosis, Procedure, Alternatives, and Post-op Instructions. For a list of presentations in each topic, see “Presentation List” on page 25.

### To play an individual presentation

- 1 Open the **Main Menu**.
- 2 Select a topic.
- 3 In the topic menu, select a presentation.
- 4 When the presentation ends, select another presentation from the topic menu, or select any of the available [navigational icons](#).



**Individual Presentation:** After selecting a topic at the **Main Menu** (such as **Extractions**), select any of the presentations to play.

## Playing Linked Presentations

You can play preset sequences of presentations that often go together. These sequences are called **Links**.

### To play linked presentations

- 1 Open the **Main Menu** and select a topic.
- 2 On the topic menu, select **Links** (chain/links icon).
- 3 On the **Links** menu, select an option to play a set of linked presentations.
- 4 When the linked presentations finish, select another set of linked presentations if desired.
- 5 To exit the **Links** menu, select any of the available **navigational icons**, or do either of the following:
  - To return to the topic menu, select **Previous** (left arrow icon).
  - To return to the **Main Menu**, select **Return** (double left arrow icon).



**Linked Presentations:** To play a preset sequence of presentations for a topic, select **Link** (chain /links icon). Then, at the **Links** menu, select your choice of linked presentations.

## Playing Previews

CAESY DVD's **Previews** feature provides an unobtrusive way to promote discretionary services by raising your patients' awareness of esthetic dentistry. It plays in a continuous loop, serving as both an internal marketing tool and a screen saver for your television or computer monitor. The **Previews** feature includes esthetic topics, hygiene presentations, before and after photos, and more.

### Starting Previews Manually

The **Previews** feature starts playing automatically after one minute of inactivity. Also, you can start **Previews** manually at any time.

#### To start Previews manually

If the **Previews** icon (window/computer screen icon) is active on the current screen, simply select it to start playing. Otherwise:

- 1 Return to the current topic menu.  
OR  
Open the **Main Menu**.
- 2 Select **Previews** (window/computer screen icon).

To **pause or stop** the loop at any time, use your computer's DVD controls or the DVD remote.



**Previews:** At any CAESY DVD menu, select the **Previews** icon to play a continuous loop of presentations that promote dental services.

### Customizing Previews

You can customize the loop. For example, you can turn some (or all) of the **Previews** options on and off, and you can turn the audio on and off. For more information, see "[Customizing CAESY DVD](#)" on page 22.

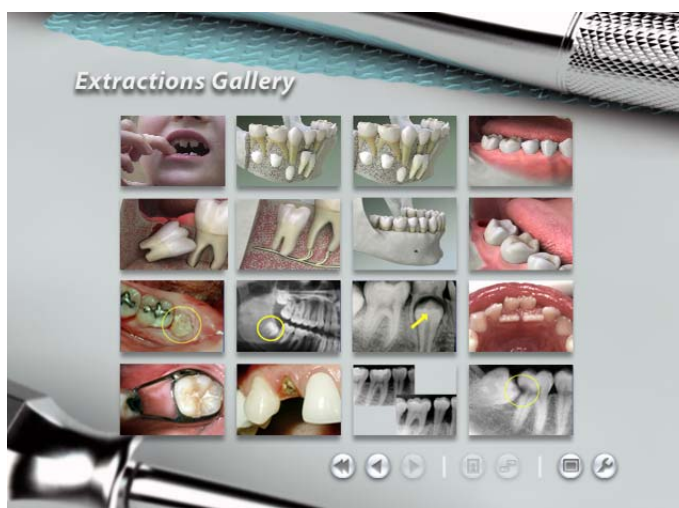
## Using Image Galleries

CAESY DVD includes a collection of silent images that you can use to accompany your own explanations of dental topics. This collection is called a **Gallery**.

- Most topic menus provide access to a **gallery** that illustrates the dental topic with videos and still images.
- The **Esthetic Solutions** topic menu serves as a gallery for the **Esthetic Dentistry** topic. The **Esthetic Solutions** menu provides access to individual galleries, each containing 12 images that illustrate esthetic procedures.

### Viewing Video Clips and Still Images

Most topic menus have a **Gallery** icon for accessing short video clips and still images. You can use individual video clips to illustrate various conditions and treatments. Also, you can view the still images or play them as a slideshow.



**Gallery:** To view silent videos about the topic, select any of the animated images in the **Gallery** menu. To view still images, select any in the bottom rows.

### To view video clips in a gallery

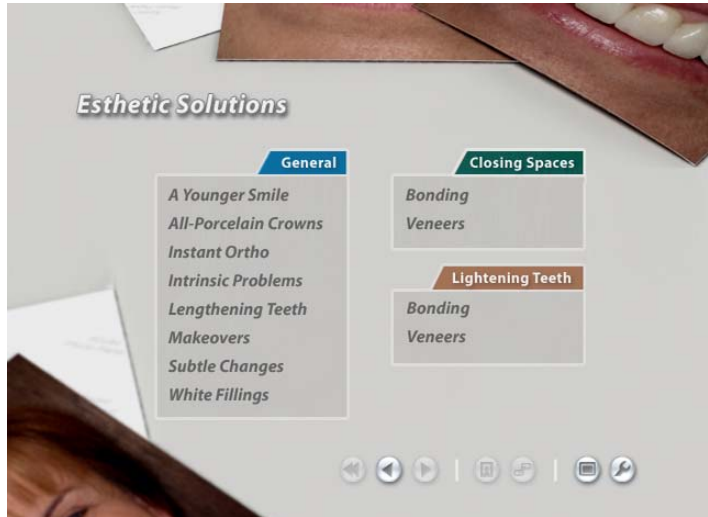
- 1 [Open](#) the **Main Menu** and select a topic.
- 2 On the topic menu, select **Gallery** (framed picture icon).
- 3 On the **Gallery** menu, select an animated image on the top row(s) to play a video clip.
- 4 When the clip ends, select another gallery item if desired.
- 5 To exit the **Gallery** menu, select **Topic Menu** or **Main Menu** as applicable, or select any of the available [navigational icons](#).

### To view still images in a gallery

- 1 [Open](#) the **Main Menu** and select a topic.
- 2 On the topic menu, select **Gallery** (framed picture icon).
- 3 On the **Gallery** menu, select any image on the rows below the animated images.
- 4 View the full-size, still image. (On a computer screen, double-click the image if necessary to make it full-size.)
- 5 Select an icon to navigate through the images:
  - To open the previous image, select **Previous** (left arrow icon).
  - To open the next image, select **Next** (right arrow icon).
  - To exit the still images and return to the topic's **Gallery** menu, select **Return** (double back arrow icon).
- 6 To exit the **Gallery** menu, select **Topic Menu** or **Main Menu** as applicable, or select any of the available [navigational icons](#).

## Viewing Esthetic Solutions Images

The **Esthetic Dentistry** and **Esthetic Solutions** topic menus work differently than the other topics. The **Esthetic Dentistry** topic does not have its own **Gallery** icon. Instead, the **Esthetic Solutions** topic functions as a gallery for it.



**Esthetic Images:** The **Esthetic Dentistry** topic menu does not have a gallery. Instead, if you select **Esthetic Solutions** at the **CAESY DVD Main Menu**, you can then select images in several galleries to illustrate esthetic dentistry solutions.

Each **Esthetic Solutions Gallery** has two sets of before and after images on each row. You can display individual images, or select a sequence of before, after, or before and after together images.

### To display Esthetic Solutions images

- 1 Open the **Main Menu** and select **Esthetic Solutions**.
- 2 On the **Esthetic Solutions** topic menu, select a category.
- 3 On the gallery of esthetic dental solutions, select a before or after image to view.



**Esthetic Solutions Galleries:** The **Esthetic Dentistry** topic menu does not have a gallery. Instead, if you select **Esthetic Solutions** at the **CAESY DVD Main Menu**, several galleries with before and after images can be selected to illustrate esthetic dentistry solutions.

- 4 Select an icon to navigate in the gallery:
  - To open the corresponding after image if you are at a before image, select **Next** (right arrow icon). Or, if you are at an after image and want to open its corresponding before image, select **Previous** (left arrow icon).
  - To open the corresponding before and after together image, select **Next** (right arrow icon) again.
  - To continue to the next before image, select **Next** again.
  - To exit the images and return to the topic's **Gallery** menu, select **Return** (double left arrow icon).

- 5 To exit the **Gallery** menu, select **Topic Menu** or **Main Menu** as applicable, or select any of the available [navigational icons](#).



***Esthetic Solutions Before and After Galleries:*** In the **Esthetic Solutions** topic menu, you can select a before image, select **Next** to view an after image, and then select **Next** again to view a before and after together image (shown above).

# Customizing CAESY DVD

## Default Settings

For your convenience, CAESY DVD comes with default settings, including:

- **Language:** English
- **Subtitles:** Off
- **Previews:** Esthetic (including Implants and Sealants) On and Hygiene Off
- **Previews Audio:** Off

However, you can change any of these settings as desired, using the **DVD Settings** (tool icon).



**CAESY DVD Settings:** You can customize the settings for language and subtitles. Also, you can turn on or turn off the entire **Previews** loop, its Esthetic presentations, Esthetic Implants, Esthetic Sealants, Hygiene, and audio.

## Language, Subtitles, and Previews Settings

### To change the CAESY DVD default settings

If the **DVD Settings** icon (tool icon) is active at the current screen, simply select it to go to the **DVD Settings** menu. Otherwise:



*Because the DVD format has no memory, customized settings are not saved when you press **Stop**, eject the DVD, or turn off the DVD. To reprogram, simply follow these steps again the next time you start CAESY DVD.*

- 1 Return to the current topic menu.  
OR  
[Open](#) the **Main Menu**.
- 2 Select **DVD Settings** (tool icon).
- 3 In the **Language** section, select **English** or **Spanish**.
- 4 In the **Subtitles** section, select **On** or **Off**.
- 5 In the **Previews** section, select the options you want.

The settings apply automatically. Depending on what you selected, CAESY DVD will do the following:

- If you selected **Previews Off**, the **Main Menu** opens after one minute.
- If you selected any of the **Previews** options, the loop begins to play automatically after one minute of inactivity.
